

Responsibilities of Authors

Authors are encouraged to adhere the following responsibilities:

- Manuscripts must be submitted in English only
- Manuscripts must be submitted with an understanding that they have not been published elsewhere (except in the form of an abstract or as part of a published lecture, review, or thesis) and are not currently under consideration for publication by any other journal
- The corresponding author is responsible for:
 - Ensuring the consent of all other co-authors for submission of the manuscript
 - Institutional or Organizational clearance
 - Submission of copyright transfer form to the Editor-in-Chief
- The corresponding author is also the contact person for any communication with the Editor-in-Chief
- Authors' active participation is essential for the timely completion of review process
- The authors are solely responsible for:
 - Correctness and authenticity of facts, figure, statements and opinions reported in the manuscript under consideration
 - Notifying the Editor-in-Chief any correction or retraction to deal with any inaccuracy, error or misrepresentation in the published version of the paper, discovered subsequent to its publication in JDOR
